The Apostle John put his hand to the pen to write his witness testimony. According to John the purpose was single-minded.

³⁰ Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. ³¹ But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

That you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God with the result that by believing you may have life in His Name. John's single purpose was to bring about a life transforming faith. That you experience the truth and that the truth set you free by believing.

Theologically rich, full of deep meaning, displaying a life lived that was deeply transformed by Jesus, reflecting on and writing selectively what was significant to simply point you to Jesus. John's writing is different in form than Matthew's and Mark's and Luke's. John includes many events the other's don't have and excludes some major events the other three contain. What this means is that John adds a depth of understanding and meaning to our Christian faith by relating events in a manner to show very explicitly Jesus is Divine, Son of God, come in human flesh, to be the perfect sacrifice that redeems.

I invite you to plan to be present each time we gather in worship. I invite you to be present on Sunday mornings. I invite you to be present on Ash Wednesday, Thursdays of Lent, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday and the Sunday's of Easter. Each time we will hear another part of John's Testimony.

I encourage you to invite a friend to come with you. Thursdays in Lent with soup supper than worship with special drama's are an excellent open heart time to bring your friend. As the soup warms your tummy, let the Gospel of John warm your heart and by God's grace you will the means of another coming to Believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. You be present, you bring your friend. God will do the rest.
