I was watching the video Bible Study *The Faith Given Once, for All* by Charles Colson. As I was listening to him talk, a couple of sentences Chuck spoke jumped out. Each time I paused the video, backed up, and listened again and again.

Here are the sentences:

What does it mean to believe? Its not enough to just have intellectual assent. Its not just enough to say I've accepted Jesus. Its not just enough to say I've made a decision. You will know you believe when your affections, your habits, your tastes, your dispositions, begin to change.

Something has to be taking place in your life where God's power, transforming power through the Holy Spirit is changing you.

"Repentant sinners who want to see their lives transformed"

Jesus Christ died for our sins. Redeemed by Grace not to live a life like others, but to live a life that each new day becomes more and more like Christ. Becoming that new creation. Living that new life in Christ. Growing into it each day. In other words growing into a mature faith.

The object is transformation. Transformation by the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Reaching for a life of holiness, a life set apart and completely consecrated to God. Putting God first in all things. This is not only for in our own lives, but in the community we live to bring about redemption in the brokenness and sickness of the culture.
