The church that we have fully funded to be built will be built in Telangana, Andhra, Pradesh, India. The pastor is Brother Pinapati Buba.



From his biography:

I was born June 16, 1978, into a nominal Christian family in

India. As Christians, we were present in the church activities, but never applied the teachings in our lives. Since none were there to correct me, I walked in my own ways. Being delighted in the company of ungodly friends, I was blind to the ways of the Lord. But there came a time when I realized the futility of the pleasures I ran after as the joy it offered me did not sustain for a long time. My family one after another took to ill health and we were thrown into a helpless condition.

The Lord used this situation to intervene in my life. As trouble gripped my being, I turned to Him for help and the Lord was gracious enough to lift us from our battered situation. I was caught hold by His love that rescued me from despair, despite my transgressions. With repentance I confessed my sins to Him and accepted Jesus as my personal Savior. Now on I started attending church with a refreshed motive and obeyed His commandment in water baptism.

In the course of my closer walk with Him, I reasoned out the

need to reach out to the millions that are yet to be saved from sin. As he confirmed my call through the Word, I committed the rest of my days to serve Him. And to be trained for this purpose, I joined a Bible school.

Out of my unquenchable thirst to reach out to the lost of my nation, I serve the Lord as an evangelist by holding open-air meeting, distributing tracts visiting houses and planting churches among the Hindu communities of India.

# INTERFAITH HOSPITALITY NETWORK

2014 WAS A BUSY YEAR FOR IHN. Through the end of November a total of 677 unduplicated individuals have been served, 356 at Norm's Place Family Shelter (154 of these were children), and 321 at the Hartley House shelter for single men. Through intensive goal setting case management, 72% of those leaving the shelters have moved into a permanent housing situation.

**OF SPRINGFIELD, INC.** 

When the extreme cold weather early in 2014 hit this area, IHN went into overflow mode, meaning that no one was turned away. The Hartley House received special permission from the Fire Department to temporarily increase their capacity, while the number of single women and families over the capacity of Norm's Place were placed in a local motel. Overflow mode was placed into operation again in November when the weather turned extreme.
