Have you ever seen the difference in a person from before and after a blood transfusion? Night and day difference in strength, energy, vigor, life itself. Now take that same image of tremendous difference for the better, and picture what God would make happen in you if you would have a Faith transfusion! Imagine what would happen in your thoughts, your conversations, your general outlook of life when the soil of your soul has been renewed and revived by the very presence of GOD!

Just like a beautiful yard takes constant care through mowing and fertilizing, your Christian Faith needs constant care. Care that is much more than Sunday Worship. Sunday Worship is like a fresh rain. Bible study is like an intentional fertilizing of your Faith. Just as your yard needs more than rain - your soul needs more than Sunday morning worship.

Open your Bible in the morning and read a portion like a taking a daily vitamin. Pray before your meals establishing gratitude in your heart for all the Lord has provided. Sing a song in perfect tune of your own creativity, or lack thereof of carrying a tune. Still sing a song, for music knits together the words of scripture with the song of the soul and is one of the best ways for the Word of Holy Scripture to penetrate deeply in your mind and heart. Then, for a weekly workout, get connected to a Bible study with brothers and sisters in Christ. Not only will you get a booster shot of Christian perspective from God's Word, you'll get to know and care more about others as Christian friendships grow.

4:30 P.M.-8:00 P.M.



Then come and enjoy an evening together!



## Get On Track and Stay There



A man bought a new hunting dog. Eager to see how he would perform, he took him out to track a bear. No sooner had they gotten into the woods than the dog picked up the trail.

Suddenly he stopped, sniffed the ground, and headed in a new direction. He had caught the scent of a deer that had crossed the bear's path. A few moments later he halted again, this time smelling a raccoon that had crossed the path of the deer. Then a turkey, a rabbit, and so on, until finally the breathless hunter caught up with his dog, only to find him barking triumphantly down the hole of a field mouse.

One of the things for which Paul prayed was for his brethren in Colossae to be able to "approve the things that are excellent" (Phil. 1:10). He used a word here that was common among metallurgists. As they tested the quality of metal, they "approved" in the metal that which was genuine. It is used, in this passage, of testing that which is good or evil. That is not always easy. Easy or not, it is the thing responsible Christians must do.

Our faith gets involved in this. We should test the excellency of our personal faith. Peter informed his readers that "for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials" but also told them how beneficial such would be. He concluded, that "your faith, which is more precious than all the gold in the world, may be proved genuine and may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed" (1 Pet. 1:6-7). The word "proved" here is the same as in Col. 1:10.

Often Christians start out with high resolve, putting the kingdom of God first in their lives, but their attention is soon diverted to things of lesser worth. One pursuit leads to another until they've strayed far from their original purpose. Let us do our best to put first things first. So, take the divine admonition and stay on track and let nothing cause you to deviate from the straight and narrow way.

*"Let your eyes look straight ahead, fix your gaze directly before you" (Prov. 4:25). "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you" (Matt. 6:33).*
