THE SMALL CATECHISM OF MARTIN LUTHER *

- Pastor. In ancient and modern times, Lent has been the time for instruction of candidates preparing for their baptism at the Easter Vigil. At the same time, the whole Church anticipates Easter through acts of repentance and spiritual renewal. It is therefore appropriate that we review the basics of The Faith during these Sundays in Lent, so that we all might be renewed by our baptismal covenants and made ready for the celebration of Easter. What is Holy Communion?
- All: Holy Communion is the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given with bread and wine, instituted by Christ Himself for us to eat and drink.
- Pastor. What benefits do we receive from this sacrament?
- All: The benefits of this sacrament are pointed out by the words, "given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sin." These words assure us that in the sacrament we receive forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. For where there is forgiveness of sins, there is also life and salvation.
- Pastor. How can eating and drinking do all this?
- All: It is not eating and drinking that does this, but the words, "given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sin." These words, along with eating and drinking, are the main thing in the sacrament. And whoever believes these words has exactly what they say, forgiveness of sins.

- Pastor. When is a person rightly prepared to receive this sacrament?
- All: Fasting and other outward preparations serve a good purpose. However, that person is well prepared and worthy who believes these words, "given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sin." But anyone who does not believe these words, or doubts them, is neither prepared nor worthy, for the words "for you" require simply a believing heart.
