Confirmation celebrates a period of discipleship instruction in the Christian faith focused on the Confessions of the Lutheran Church. Confirmation includes a public profession of faith into which the Confirmands were baptized, thus underscoring God's action in their Baptism.

THE PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION

Pastor: Brothers and sisters in Christ, let us be united as the

Church in heart and mind as we go to our heavenly

Father in prayer..

Pastor: (After each petition. . .) Lord, in your mercy;

All: hear our prayer.

Pastor: . . . Accept, O Lord, the prayers of Your faithful people

for the well being of Your holy Church throughout the world. Govern and sanctify it, with all its pastors and ministers, by Your Holy Spirit, that we may be kept by Your Word in true Faith and fervent love toward You and

one another.

All: Amen.

THE SERVICE OF HOLY COMMUNION

Pastor: The Lord be with you.

All: and also with you.

Pastor: Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them to the Lord.

Pastor: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

THE WORDS OF INSTITUTION
